

## **RECORD OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATION (REC)**

**PROJECT TITLE:** REC Building 433 Repairs (EWR # 2021341-DPW-1)

**DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED ACTION:** Repair B433 envelope including exterior walls and roof. Building ventilation repairs to include HV industrial wall fans. Repairs to Break room, bathrooms and office spaces to include walls, lighting, ceiling, fixtures and HVAC systems. Repairs to the interior and exterior lighting to include LED fixtures. Building perimeter concrete repairs to include cracks, holes and missing sections of concrete. Overhead doors repair to include more effective and safer doors. Repairs to the fire alarm system to effectively communicate to ANAD's emergency services. Repairs to the facility electrical system to include repairs to all electrical services and panels. Hazardous material abatement to include removal of all heavy metal dust in building, Abatement will be done to minimize exposure to building personnel.

**ANTICIPATED DATE AND/OR DURATION OF PROPOSED ACTION:** Undefined repair time frame beginning in FY2022.

**REVIEW:** At the present time there are no known natural or cultural concerns with this action. This action will not be associated with any Solid Waste Management Units (SWMU's) on ANAD. This project falls under 32 CFR Part 651, App B,(g)(1) Routine repair and maintenance of buildings, airfields, grounds, equipment, and other facilities. Examples include, but are not limited to: Removal and disposal of asbestos-containing material (for example, roof material and floor tile) or lead-based paint in accordance with applicable regulations; removal of dead, diseased, or damaged trees; and repair of roofs, doors, windows, or fixtures (REC required for removal and disposal of asbestos-containing material and lead-based paint or work on historic structures). 32 CFR Part 651, App B,(g)(4) Routine management, to include transportation, distribution, use, storage, treatment, and disposal of solid waste, medical waste, radiological and special hazards (for example, asbestos, PCBs, lead-based paint, or unexploded ordnance), and/or hazardous waste that complies with EPA, Army, or other regulatory agency requirements. This CX is not applicable to new construction of facilities for such management purposes.

A signed REC is required before work is commenced (40 CFR Part 1500.1 (b). This project involves no apparent impact to natural or cultural resources 32 CFR 651.29 Categorical Exclusion screening criteria was applied to this project; it was determined that this project has not been segmented, no extraordinary circumstances or situations exist and the use of the designated Categorical Exclusion is appropriate. The criteria in 32 CFR 651 have been applied and are met.
